

IDLING POLICY

In order to minimise vehicle emissions that negatively impact on the environment and health, Dual Seal Glass Ltd is committed to reducing vehicle idling times within the company premises, in stationary traffic queues and at any other times unnecessary idling takes place. The company actively encourages drivers to reduce levels of idling.

Dual Seal Glass is committed to:

- Implementing anti-idling measurements to reduce unnecessary vehicle idling, reduce wasted fuel, improve air quality, and protect members of the public health.
- Ensuring the fitment of factory fitted cut out systems on new fleet vehicles
- Actively monitor and review the engine idling levels of the fleet on a monthly basis with the use of vehicle telematic systems.
- Implementing corrective actions to reduce the amount of engine idle time.
- Promoting practical steps to sustain good practice, to reduce the environmental impacts of our driving activities
- Ensuring that all employees are fully aware of this policy and are committed to follow company procedures and making improvements where necessary
- Co-Operate with members of other organisations and members of the public to ensure that complaints are dealt with in the necessary manner.

This policy applies to all employees of Dual Seal Glass those who drive in connection with their employment and will be reviewed at least annually.
